Dear Tera,

As you are aware, on May 14, 2020, the Province of Ontario announced an additional [easing of restrictions](#) on [certain workplaces and services](#) as part of the phased approach outlined previously in its framework for re-opening.

As a result of the Ontario government's announcement, there are **NO** immediate changes to the previous directives and guidelines provided by the College to Members.

However, this measured approach to reopening allows time for health care providers to prepare for an eventual reopening, and to ensure that clinics and workplaces are safe for staff, patients, and practitioners.

In keeping with this approach, the College has prepared the [COVID-19 Pandemic Clinical Practice Directive](#) to be followed when the provincial government authorizes a return to full, or non-urgent, in-person chiropody/podiatry services. **Please access this document at <http://cocoo.on.ca/wp-content/uploads/2020/05/DRAFT-COCOO-Pandemic-Directive-for-Members-final-May-17th.pdf>**

**Until that authorization is granted, members must continue to follow the previously announced [Ministry of Health Directive #2](#), and the previous College correspondence governing the provision of urgent/emergency care only.**
