Advisories We Are Working On

The College is also working on updating practice issues relating to orthotics based on the many questions we have received. As well, the College is developing guidance to assist members in preparing for the eventual return to practice. We are working with the government and the CMOH to clarify timing, guidelines and access to personal protective equipment. Please watch your e-mail for these updates.

And presently...

The provincial government has extended all emergency orders, including those that call for the closure of non-essential workplaces, until at least May 19. This direction may change in the coming weeks, however, there is currently no set date for a return to practice for chiropractors and podiatrists and other health care providers. Our members should avoid scheduling non-urgent appointments until a restart date has been released as the existing directive from the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) remains in place.

We know chiropractors and podiatrists are very eager to prepare for the return to practice and we will share our guidance as soon as it is available.
